Location:


Ivory Lodge "Place of Elephants" is located on a private concession of 6,000 acres in Hwange. The lodge is 2.5 kilometers off the Bulawayo / Victoria Falls main road. The Lodge offers the chance to relax and unwind, allowing you to soak in the beauty of the African serenity. Our concession is home to an abundance of wildlife including herds of elephant and buffalo up to 300 strong, both of which are regular residents at the water hole situated in front of the Lodge.

Access:

Ivory is accessible by road using the Bulawayo / Victoria Falls main road. The distance from Bulawayo is 258 kilometers and from Victoria Falls 180 kilometers. Hwange airport is 8 kilometers away. We have a transfer company 'Driving You Wild' which facilitates transfers nationwide and can be booked through our central reservation team.

Accommodation:

The accommodation comprises of 9 thatched tree-house style rooms with a total capacity of 20 people. 3 are double rooms which have queen size beds, 3 are twins with two single beds, 1 family orientated room with two double beds and lastly, we have two tented suites, both having queen size beds. All rooms are fitted with mosquito nets and all rooms are fairly open, therefore we provide electric blankets during our winter months. The lodges have a scenic view of the water hole, offering our guests a more intimate safari experience





Activities:

Experienced guides will accompany you on all activities. It is a photographic lodge and is situated in the hub of the African bush.

Ivory lodge is in the key home range of the Presidential Elephant herd made famous by Alan Elliot in the 1980's. If you are requesting a specific elephant experience, our guides are familiar with this herd of semi-habituated elephants.

Facts and Facilities:

- The Lodge's entertainment area provides a full bar with a wide variety of local and imported beverages
- Tea and coffee station
- Swimming pool
- Upstairs library with elevated view of the waterhole
- Waterhole is floodlit at night
- Game viewings from the hide
- Borehole water throughout camp
- Laundry service
- Credit card facilities available: ONLY Visa & Mastercard accepted

Tuskers Campsite:

For those on a budget, our campsite is available, with a main gazebo area for food preparation and a bar. Directly behind is an ablution block that has two toilets and two showers for both men and women. A platform is situated in front of the campsite to allow an enhanced view of the water hole. This campsite can also be booked through our central reservations team.
