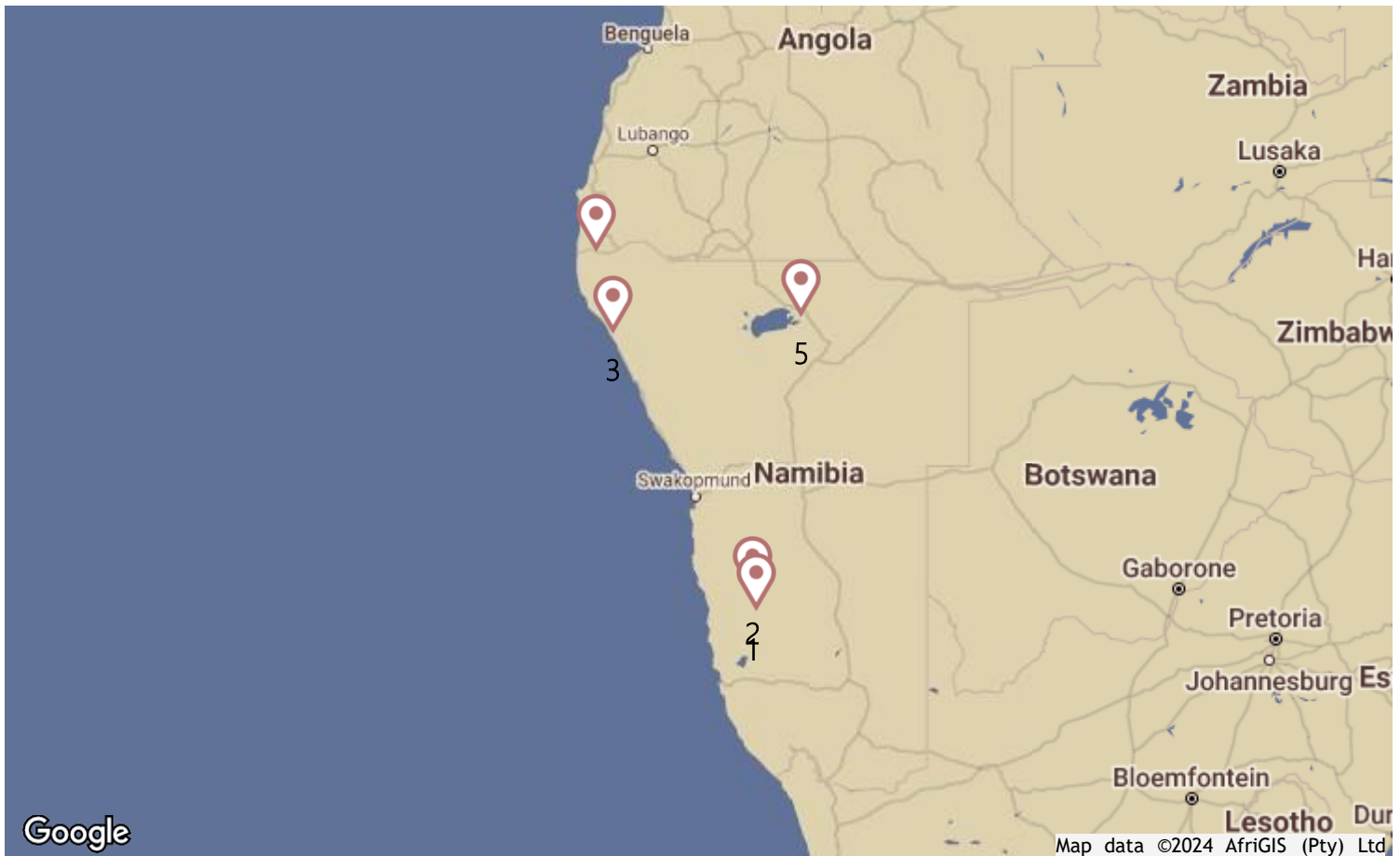

NamibRand Nature Reserve

Area Overview

An area that epitomises wide open spaces of red sand, gravel plains, mountain ranges, dunes and savannas. One of the most beautiful and scenic in Namibia. Everywhere you look, the perfect panoramic photo. Pure wilderness. Untouched. Pristine.

The NamibRand Reserve, south of [Sossusvlei](#) in the southwest of Namibia is one of the largest private reserves in Southern Africa, covering an area of **215,000 hectares**. It borders the Namib Naukluft Park to the west for 100 kilometres and the Nubib Mountains to the east.

The area is known to host numbers around **3200 oryx** and more than **12,400 springbok** as well as kudu, Hartmann's and Burchell's zebra, giraffe, klipspringer, steenbok, hartebeest and baboons. Predators include **leopard, Spotted and Brown hyena, black-backed jackal**, aardwolf, bat-eared fox, Cape fox, African wildcat, caracal and genet. More than **150 species of bird** have been recorded in the area along with numerous species of different fauna and flora.

Property Overview

Positioned on the edge of a 250-metre high dune, Dune Camp has the most extraordinary views across the Namibrand reserve. The main areas are spread out across a series of interlocking decks ensuring that the lounge, dining area, and tea room all enjoy views across the endless dune landscape to the mountains beyond.

The six tented and wooden structures are designed for the desert. The canvas sides can all be opened up capturing the cool breeze in the hot summer months, and in winter keeping you warm when the canvas sides are rolled down.

Experience & Activities

Wolwedans is about experiences, people, and the endless landscapes that will shift your perspective forever. Where you lay your head is important but it's nothing compared to what you will experience on the Namibrand reserve.

Area Overview

Star dunes with up to five crests rise 300m into the air and rank among the biggest in the world; the dune valleys are marked by vast clay pans where the Tsauchab River gave up its fight to reach the sea more than 60,000 years ago.

Besides the dunes and pans of Sossusvlei and Sesriem Canyon, a sideshow of activities and sights has developed around the region and there are plenty of game lodges that provide additional desert-adapted activities. Plants and birds are the dominant life form in this dessicated realm and they support a tiny world of mammals, reptiles and insects that, in the absence of coastal fog, seldom wander far from the rivercourse and its pans.

The Skeleton Coast National Park is the northern stretch, north of Ugab River Gate and beyond Terrace Bay. A vast, brooding and impenetrable national park. Bleak too and one of the most inhospitable places in the world. Cold water and an expanse of dunes, this is the driest place in sub-Saharan Africa and the final resting place of more than a thousand rusting shipwrecks. The turbulent Benguela Current causes strong winds, shifting sandbanks and powerful undertows that have led to many a sailor's demise. It's a true testament to the humbling power of nature's forces.

Explore what is left of shipwreck skeletons that met their fate on the treacherous Atlantic Coast by the ever changing sandbanks, heavy fog and torrent currents. Take a scenic flight over the endless dunes, old diamond mines, shipwrecks and along the deserted coastline. Visit one of the largest Cape fur seal colonies in the world at the Cape Cross Seal Reserve.

Uniquely designed around the enigmatic shipwrecks that line Namibia's Skeleton Coast, there's nowhere on the continent quite like Shipwreck Lodge. In the centre of camp, you'll find an equally as innovatively-designed lounge and restaurant with a wide, wraparound deck and uninterrupted views across the sand all the way to the Atlantic Ocean.

Stay at Shipwreck Lodge and game drive in search of desert-dwelling fauna; discover the enchanting desert flora (succulents and lichens); sit atop the dunes as the sun sinks below the horizon; spend the day beach-combing for whale bones and debris from centuries of shipwrecks; and marvel at the geologically-remarkable Clay Castles. Really, there's nowhere like it on earth.

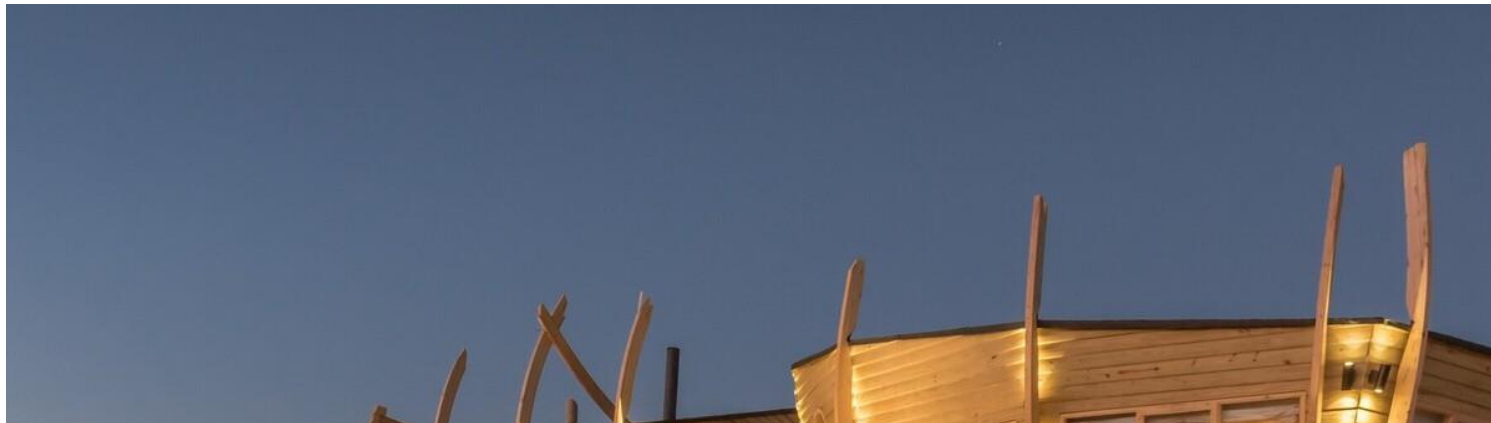

Kaokoland

Area Overview

The Kaokoveld, a vast and empty wilderness occupying the north-western quarter of Namibia, is roughly divided in two by the Hoanib River. It's harsh, remote, unpopulated and makes for some of Namibia's finest scenic landscapes.

This **isolated rugged region** is home to the nomadic **Himba** pastoralists who have remained unchanged for many generations. The attraction of Kaokoland lies in its wild and uncharted valleys and mountains. It is the most isolated and undeveloped region of this mostly isolated and undeveloped country.

Track desert-adapted elephant, lion and rhino on foot or in specially modified safari vehicles; explore Palmwag, Marienfluss and Hartmann's Valleys; visit a Himba village and learn how they survive in this seemingly uninhabitable place; seek out a Welwitschia or a mysterious Lone Man sculpture; tackle Van Zyl's Pass; camp wild; discover miraculous plants, animals, birds and reptiles; get outside yourself and delve deep into the great, great beyond.

The Ozonganda (Herero, meaning “main area”) affords spectacular views over the Kunene River.

In this isolated area, the Himba people continue their traditional semi-nomadic way of life and, when they are in the area, guests have an opportunity to learn about their lifestyle and customs. One of the highlights, guided quad bike excursions through the fragile environs, is done with utmost care along specifically allocated pathways, so as to tread lightly on the dunes and preserve the unique and delicate habitats of this landscape.

Boating on the Kunene River provides guests with the opportunity to venture through the lush riverside oases. Crocodiles and waterbirds seem out of place in this surreal, lunar-like landscape. You can also experience informative nature drives in open Land Rovers that allow guests to experience the true Namib in its unbridled glory. Walking provides unique opportunities to see the smaller denizens of the desert, from the famous fairy circles to the desert chameleon.
