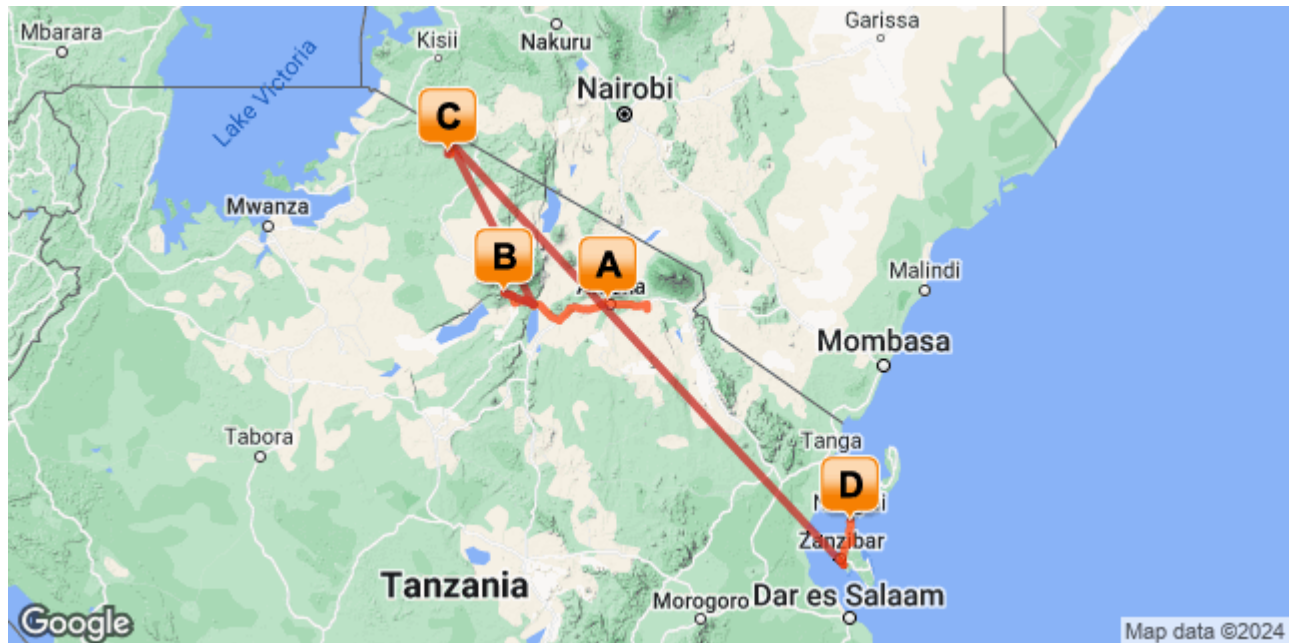

Day Itinerary

Welcome to Tanzania. You will be met at Kilimanjaro International Airport by our immigration representative who will assist you with your VIP immigration clearance. Your driver will meet you outside the VIP entrance building and transfer you from the airport to the lovely Legendary Lodge. The drive is about 90 minutes. You will overnight at Legendary Lodge on full board (all meals included) for one night.

Legendary Lodge is located at the foothills of Mount Meru, on the outskirts of the bustling town of Arusha and is the gateway to the Northern Safari Circuit of Tanzania. This classic haven boasts lush tropical gardens and is surrounded by a working coffee farm. The peaceful cottages are the perfect place to prepare for or reflect on your safari.

Featuring split-level living, king size beds with mosquito nets and all the comforts of a modern home, including satellite television, direct dial telephone, broadband internet and a private bar.

Guests can indulge in gourmet meals including a full English breakfast, delicious lunches and romantic candle-lit dinners, served with a selection of fine wines.

Optional activities offered are a savory coffee tour, shopping at the nearby Cultural Heritage Centre or an excursion to Arusha, Tarangire and Manyara National Parks or other nearby attractions. Explore the estate and the lush gardens through cycling or walking trails. The lodge spa also offers rejuvenating treatments – after a long flight, ease your body into African time with a relaxing massage.

The lodge is conveniently located, a mere fifteen minutes' drive from Arusha Airport and 90 minutes from Kilimanjaro International Airport.

Day 2 Itinerary

Today you will be transferred after breakfast at 08.30am to Arusha airport, for your flight on Coastal Aviation to Manyara airstrip with Coastal Aviation, departing at 09.25am, landing at 10.00am. Your private guide will meet and transfer you to Ngorongoro Crater Lodge, where you will spend 2 nights.

- 08.30am: After breakfast, transfer to Arusha Airport
- 09.25am: Fly with Coastal Aviation to Manyara airstrip
- 10.00am: After landing, your private guide will transfer you to Crater Lodge where you will spend 2 nights.
- 13:00pm: Lunch at Crater Lodge.
- 14:00pm: Afternoon game drive in the Ngorongoro Crater with your private guide and vehicle



Nearly three million years old, the ancient caldera shelters one of the most beautiful wildlife havens on earth. Endangered black rhino are protected within its rim, giant tusked elephant wander the forests, male lion stalk the grasslands and flamingo crowd the soda lakes.

Nowhere else on earth can you wake up among all the trappings of an elegant baroque châteaux that transports you into one of the most famous African landscapes. An eclectic blend of teak panelling, Victorian furnishings and whimsical African touches creates a sumptuous atmosphere that is as elegant and unique as the Crater itself. In this place of dramatic contrasts, anything is possible, and the natural luxury of the beautiful setting ensures the dramatic interior of your suite blends perfectly with its stilted thatch architecture.

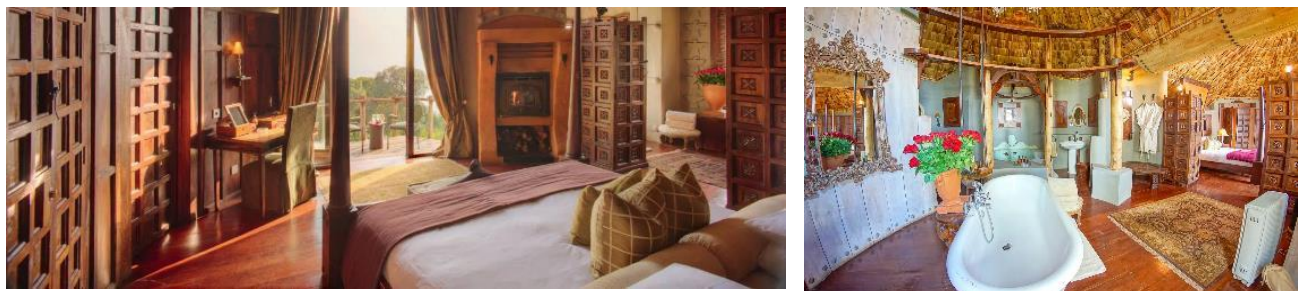
Overnight: Ngorongoro Crater Lodge

Perched on the edge of the Ngorongoro Crater, and Beyond Ngorongoro Crater Lodge comprises three separate camps totalling just 30 suites. Each stilted, handcrafted mud and thatch suite is adorned with antiques, chandeliers and elegant African treasures and floor-to-ceiling windows overlook the magnificent Crater below.



Ensuite bathrooms feature spacious showers and chandelier-lit bathtubs. A personal butler discretely caters for each guest's every need, bringing tea in bed, stoking fireplaces and drawing luxurious bubble baths. Frequently described as Masai meets Versailles, each camp has its own guest sitting and dining areas, as well as viewing decks. The domed dining room, with its fireplace, crystal, silver and massive wooden platters, turns every meal into a special occasion.

Day 3: Ngorongoro Crater Lodge, Ngorongoro Crater

Ngorongoro Crater

Located in Northern Tanzania, the Ngorongoro Crater is best known for its natural beauty and abundance of diverse wildlife; which makes it one of Africa's most popular safari destinations. Surrounded by Tanzania's highlands, this UNESCO-listed crater is said to be the world's largest intact volcanic caldera. Visitors can look forward to spotting the world-renowned Big Five and a host of other wildlife species including large herds of zebra and wildebeest. It is famed as one of Tanzania's best tourist attractions

offering visitors an array of wonderful activities including excellent bird watching, trekking, wildlife viewing, mountain biking and visiting a local Maasai village. Don't miss the opportunity to jump on an excursion to the magnificent Olduvai Gorge.

Day Itinerary

Today you will enjoy another game drive into the Crater. This time you will explore the Ngorongoro Crater early in the morning. You will descend into the crater through a lush highland forest, with magnificent birdlife to be spotted among the different tree species. Once on the grassy crater floor, you may discover a large variety of grazing herbivores, as well as the predators that are attracted by this abundant supply of prey. Depending on the time of year, you may see huge flocks of pink flamingo around the shores of the shallow Lake Magadi, while the surrounding swamp is inhabited by hippo. After lunch at the crater floor you will be brought back to the Ngorongoro Crater Lodge where you can relax for the afternoon and enjoy this spectacular place.

- 06.00am: Departure Crater Lodge for descend into the Ngorongoro Crater.
- 13:00pm: Return to Crater Lodge.
- 13:30pm: Lunch at the lodge.
- 14:30pm: Afternoon of leisure and dinner at the lodge.



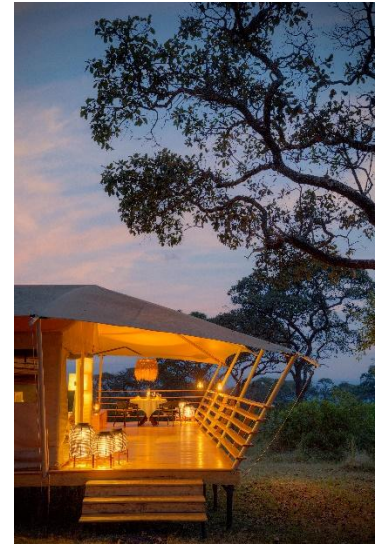

- 11.30am: Fly with Coastal Aviation to Kogatende airstrip.
- 13.00pm: After landing, transfer with your guide to the wonderful Serengeti Bushtops Camp, where you will spend 3 nights. Game drives are in an open safari vehicle and guide from the camp. The game drives are shared with other guests.

On these days in the Serengeti, you will go on game drives with world-class guides in your open safari vehicles. You can go out for the entire day, or you can return to camp for lunch. It's all up to you! Go where the day takes you, be it a full day out with a picnic in the wilderness, or a lazy siesta back in camp before that ice-cold sundowner... As the setting sun draws the day to a close, head back to camp and join us round the campfire – the perfect gathering spot to share a pre-dinner drink and stories of the dwindling day.

Under Serengeti Bushtops canvas lies the finest in seductive luxury and fifteen of the largest, most impressive tented en suites imaginable. None of the tents are overlooked, but all look over the Serengeti. Each faces the sunset and is open on two sides, giving you an extraordinary panoramic view of nature's living masterpiece.



Serengeti Bushtops' 15 luxurious rooms under canvas are named after the animals that surround them. Each is encircled by vast private decks, creating a hundred and twenty square metres within which to sink into a deck lounge, soak in your private hot tub or gaze out at passing wildlife. This is your personal kingdom, ideally suited to restful sleep, taking an open-air shower beneath the warm African sun, or unwinding as you await drinks from your private butler.



Enjoy a cocktail by the fire or make use of our library and internet facilities. Sundowner: It is a classic moment, immortalized in films, fantasies and a million great safari adventures: watching the sun set over the African bush. There's simply nothing like it. You may see a burnished disk slip gracefully from view. If not, the clouds will diffuse an amazing palette of color, flooding the horizon. Either way, you'll be part of an incredible experience which will live on in your mind's eye, for ever. Serengeti Bushtops isn't just the perfect place for a safari: it includes the ideal spot for a sundowner. We call it Simba's rock. The reason is simple. Simba means lion and our favored sundowner location is theirs too! Needless to say, if they are there first, our advance team swiftly detours to prepare one of several alternative options. Usually, though, we're able to look across the Serengeti plains from Simba's Rock, watching the sun set on paradise.

Klipspringer dining: The perfect end to the perfect day: total privacy in your own illuminated corner of the darkening Serengeti. That is what our Klipspringer dining experience delivers, within a setting of charm and intimacy. The surrounding rocks, of the sort favoured by local Klipspringer antelope, form a natural amphitheatre. Within this magical haven, lanterns and a bonfire turn beauty into wonder, creating the ideal spot for a sumptuous meal, prepared by our executive chef. As day turns to night in the Serengeti, has life ever been this good?!

Bush walk: One of the many advantages of being located in the heart of the Serengeti is being able to run nature walks within the Camp's grounds. These are not chargeable -but for anyone wanting something even more memorable, an armed Tanapa ranger will accompany you, your ranger and spotter on a walking safari at a Tanapa designated area, along the banks of the Mara River. Your ranger and local Kuria tribesman will come along to spot and interpret the animals' tracks left from the night before and identify the flora and fauna, explaining for example which are used for medicinal purposes by their tribe. All you need is a pair of good walking shoes and a sense of adventure!

Private bush breakfast: Each moment on safari is extraordinary, but some moments really stand out. A relaxed breakfast in the heart of the Serengeti is just such a moment – surreal yet oh-so-real at the same time. As you gaze around you, the idea of ever leaving these magical lands seems unthinkable. Your private breakfast follows an early morning wake-up call, before driving through the breaking dawn to a favored spot from which to watch the sun rise. No one else is around: just you, a friend or loved one, plus our chef and your driver, serving a hot meal and an array of delicious buffet delicacies. Watch, listen, inhale deeply – and smile: this is special.

Balloon safari: There is nothing quite like soaring high above the herds in a hot air balloon, as the sun rises over the Serengeti. You will be picked up from Serengeti Bushtops before dawn, ready to take off as the sun makes its appearance. The flight lasts an unforgettable hour, before your balloon is brought gracefully back to earth – and a celebratory Bush champagne breakfast. You can then head off on a full day's day game drive or return to camp for a more leisurely morning and even a return to bed, to catch up on lost sleep.



Northern Serengeti

The vast, rolling savanna of the Northern Serengeti, is known as the hub of the great migration. The landscape is characterized by vast stretches of savanna interspersed with acacia trees and riverine woodlands. Wildlife can be seen along the banks of the Mara River and visitors can view the annual spectacle of the half a million migrating wildebeest. Commonly spotted wildlife include: a multitude of plains game such as buffalo, zebra, gazelles, impala, giraffe as well as lion and leopard. Visitors can look forward to bird watching, hot air ballooning, game safaris and guided bush walks.
