Day 1: House of Waine, Nairobi

Day Itinerary

Welcome to Kenya. You will arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport and be met by our immigration representative who will assist you with your VIP immigration clearance. Your private driver will meet you outside the arrival terminal holding a sign with your name for your private transfer to House of Waine. The transfer is about 45 minutes.

Sheldrick Wildlife Trust - Elephant Orphanage

Born from one family's passion for Kenya and its wilderness, the Sheldrick Wildlife Trust was established more than 40 years ago and is best known for its Orphans' Project, the first and most successful elephant orphan rescue and rehabilitation program in the world. The Sheldrick Trust is a pioneering conservation organisation, dedicated to the protection of wildlife and the preservation of habitats in East Africa.

During this time the orphans can be witnessed enjoying a milk feed and mud bath (or soil dusting on cooler days). The visit is intended to provide an opportunity for visitors to learn about the work of the Sheldrick Wildlife Trust in the rescue and rehabilitation of orphaned elephants, with one of our keepers giving a talk throughout the visiting hour, during which time they will tell the stories of the different orphans in our care and explain about the process of raising milk dependent baby elephants. With information provided about the wider threats facing elephants and the reasons there are orphans, as well as the work being done by the Sheldrick Trust and other organizations to protect elephants and wildlife in Kenya, the visit is both educational and informative. Throughout the talk, the elephants will be enjoying themselves eating greens, drinking their milk, playing with one another and on hotter days splashing about in the mud.



Entrance to the Nairobi National Park fee is US\$50 dollars per person and entrance to the Orphanage for the visiting hour requires a minimum contribution of US\$20 dollars per person. There is also a small gift shop setup on-site, which is open during the public visiting hour, and there is the opportunity to adopt any of the orphans in our care - many of whom visitors will see on the day. Funds generated from the gift shop and adoptions are used to help cover costs incurred in the rescue and hand-raising of orphaned elephants and their protection in the wild.

Giraffe Centre

The Giraffe Centre is the creation of the African Fund for Endangered Wildlife (A.F.E.W. Kenya), a Kenyan non-profit organisation. The main purpose is to educate Kenyan school children and youth on their country's wildlife and environment, as well as give local and international visitors an opportunity to come into close contact with the world's tallest species, the giraffe.

Breeding of the endangered Rothschild Giraffe is one of the main programmes. The calves are then released into the wild at two to three-years-old when they are independent enough to survive. So far more than 40 giraffes have been released into safe game parks and conservancies across the country.

The Giraffe Centre is open from 9 AM to 5 PM, seven days a week. Feeding and tours operate throughout this time. Remember to carry a valid Identification Card with you. Proceeds from entry fees go towards our conservation education work with students and teachers across Kenya. The price is US\$15 for adults and US\$7.50 for children (3-12 years old) and can be paid by a debit or credit card only.

Day 3 - 6: Mara Bushtops Camp, Masai Mara

Day Itinerary

Today after breakfast you will be transferred to Wilson Airport for your flight to Siana airstrip in the Masai Mara. On arrival, your guide and vehicle from Mara Bushtops will meet and transfer you to Mara Bushtops where you will have lunch. The drive to Mara Bushtops is about 30 minutes. After lunch, your guide will take you on an afternoon game drive in this beautiful area, returning to camp before sunset.

You will overnight at Mara Bushtops for three nights in luxury tents. The game drives are shared game drives.

Mara Bushtops boasts a sensational location in front of the largest natural salt lick in the Masai Mara and perched on the side of a hill, with a scenic valley to one side. Set amid the Bushtops private Conservancy bordering the Masai Mara, Activities such as walking safaris, night game drives, off road game drives, sun downers, bush breakfasts are part of the experience. Game drives are conducted in open converted 4x4's and accompanied by a professional Ranger and local Masai spotter.



Mara Bushtops is an oasis of five-star luxury, blending peace with adventure - and first-class comfort with unforgettable sights and smells, sounds and sensations. It is just a 4.5 km drive to the main gate of the National Park and within striking distance of the beautiful Mara River.

Today after breakfast you will be transferred to Siana airstrip for your domestic flight to Loisaba airstrip. On arrival, you will be met by your private guide and vehicle and transferred to Ol Lentille. The drive takes about 1,5 hours. At Ol Lentille, you will be accommodated in one of the villas.



Overnight: Ol Lentille

Ol Lentille is a lodge that is proud to be different. With 360 degree spectacular views, we have a secluded private conservation area where all your activities and meals are private. There are four very special private villas, newly renovated with luxurious contemporary interiors. Laikipia

Known as one of Kenya's best safari areas, and renowned for its protection of rare animals, the high plains of Laikipia feature vast open stretches of African savanna scattered with game including Grevy's zebras, lions, leopards, black rhinos, wild dogs, buffalos, giraffes, lesser kudu, gerenuk, Beisa oryx, Jackson's hartebeest, Somali ostrich, and thousands of elephants.
