Amenities

Design

- The 11- bedrooms in the main House are all individually styled and then named to reflect their different themes ensuring that no two are exactly alike.
- The cosy Cottage sleeps 3, a double in the master room complete with a fireplace and a single. The Cottage has an open plan lounge (with a fireplace), Dining room, Kitchen and private garden.
- 4 of our bedrooms can be single, double or twin rooms; 4 of our bedrooms can be single, double, twin or triple rooms; among which 2 sets of interconnecting rooms for families.
- Each bedroom features a large marble bathroom with plenty of natural light through the large windows.
- All bathrooms have a separate shower and bath and all have a complete range of toiletries, hairdryers and bathroom telephone except 1 bedroom without a bath tub.

Cuisine

The menu is varied and reflects the diversity to be found in Nairobi today, which ensures that most guests will find something they will enjoy. It is a set menu that gives guests two options for each course and changes daily.
